

MULDHAI TREK



Trip Overview

The Muldhai View Point Trek is a short and fresh trekking destination. It stands at 3637m and it provides eyes level 360 degree magnificent panoramic mountains views of Annapurna, ranges of Dhaulagiri, Lamjung, Fishtail, Gangapurna and diversity landscapes of surrounding valley. The Muldhai View point itself is located onward east of Ghorepani. The trail is newly built, it offers comfortable accommodation and warm hospitality of different ethnic groups. Just this trek is settled for 10 days, can be shorter, but it can be also flexibly extended and linked with other sections of the Annapurna trail. Due to the low elevation is also suitable for family with children.

Trip Itinerary

- Day 01 - Kathmandu to Pokhara by flight, stay overnight at a hotel in Pokhara (850m)
- Day 02 - Drive to Nayapul (1070m), Trek to Purna Gaun
- Day 03 - Lespar Village
- Day 04 - Nangi Village
- Day 05 - Mohare Camp
- Day 06 - Watch outstanding view, then trek to Ghorepani (2750m)
- Day 07 - Tadapani (2610m)
- Day 09 - Early morning Muldhai view point (3637m), then trek to Ghandruk (1940m)
- Day 10 - Drive back Pokhara by jeep 3hrs drive, then afternoon flight back to Kathmandu (1350m)
